Ordering Influenza Vaccines

- Influenza vaccines are listed on the WA Health vaccine online ordering system at <https://wa.tollhealthcare.com/> and can be ordered with your standard vaccines.
- Influenza orders will be delivered from week commencing Monday 16th April 2018, in line with your standard delivery arrangements and ordering deadlines:
 - In the metropolitan area, vaccines are delivered according to the fortnightly delivery schedule; orders must be placed by 12 noon two business days before your delivery day (as displayed on the online system).
 - In regional WA, vaccines are delivered to regional distribution centres the week after you place your order, for on-shipment to you.
- Collect orders will be available from Monday 30th April 2018 for metropolitan providers. **Collect order requests require prior approval by Vaccine Orders.**
- If you wish to collect an order, please include a note in your order specifying the day you wish to collect. Once Vaccine Orders have approved your request, the system generates a confirmation email that includes the date and time, together with the collect instructions from the Toll Warehouse. Due to the volume of orders at this time, please wait for the email order confirmation. We ask that you bring the email order confirmation with you when you collect your order.
- We encourage you not to over order influenza vaccines, to avoid influenza vaccine wastage.
