

HIV PrEP Update for GPs and Practice Nurses

A landmark in HIV prevention drugs, PrEP (tenofovir with emtricitabine) is now approved for use on the Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme, thereby providing broader access for any doctor, general practitioner, and endorsed nurse practitioner to be able to prescribe PrEP to an eligible Australian resident who holds a current Medicare card.

This training will provide GPs, Nurses, and Health Professionals working in primary care an update on strategies available for the prevention of HIV transmission, focusing on prevention particularly pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP).

At the end of this update, participants will be able to:

- Describe HIV epidemiology in Australia and the different HIV prevention strategies
- Explain the role of HIV treatment and management
- Provide patient education on the effectiveness and appropriate use of PrEP/PEP
- Identify the prescribing pathways of PrEP within your local jurisdiction
- Implement different HIV prevention strategies
