Dear Doctor,

Telemed Health Services, in conjunction with Boulder-Rotary, is pleased to offer the Goldfields region a telehealth specialist service to support GP's in the area. Several Perth based specialists have made themselves available for free, no out-of-pocket telehealth consultations.

We would like to introduce the following specialists:

Dr Oyekoya Ayonrinde - Gastroenterologist

Dr Koya Ayonrinde is a Gastroenterologist and Hepatologist working exclusively in the southern suburbs of Perth in the public and private sector. He is a staff specialist at Fiona Stanley Hospital and Fremantle Hospital and provides endoscopy services at Bentley Hospital under the ASI program and as a visiting medical practitioner (direct referral of uninsured public patients). He has admitting rights to St John of God Murdoch Hospital, where he also performs day case colonoscopy or gastroscopy/ endoscopy procedures for privately referred patients.

Koya has clinical and research interests in general gastroenterology and general hepatology, including bowel cancer and polyp screening, coeliac disease, peptic ulcer disease, functional dyspepsia and irritable bowel syndrome, abnormal LFTs, nonalcoholic and alcoholic fatty liver disease, cirrhosis, drug-induced, autoimmune and viral hepatitis.

Dr Krishna Chikkaveerappa- Endocrinology

Dr Krish graduated from Bangalore (India) in 2000. He underwent physician and specialist endocrinology training in Liverpool (UK) and worked as a consultant in the UK. Dr Krish have fellowships from the UK, Ireland and Australia. He has a special interest in and holds post-graduate qualifications in teaching in clinical practice. He also has a special research interest in diabetes. Currently, he is working as a consultant physician and endocrinologist at Rockingham General Hospital. Dr Krish has been actively involved in supporting medical students in his Physician coordinator role attached to The University of Western Australia and describes himself as passionate specialist in providing high level patient care and empowering patients in decision making. He values good communication with primary care physicians and patients.

Dr Vinothkumar (Vino) Kavarthapol Jayaraman- Nephrology

Vino (Dr Vinothkumar Kavarthapol Jayaraman) did postgraduate Infectious Diseases degree at UWA (2008) after completing M.B.B.S. He underwent physician training and specialisation in Nephrology and Internal Medicine and received FRACP in 2018. He practices in all areas of Nephrology from mild chronic kidney disease to end stage renal failure and manages patients who are on different dialysis modality. He works in the field of Internal medicine and Nephrology at Rockingham General Hospital, Fiona Stanley Hospital and

Peel Health Campus and is actively involved in teaching and clinical research. Apart from the above hospitals, Vino provides comprehensive specialist outpatient services at Peel Health campus, Antony Street Specialist Centre and Rockingham Specialist Centre.

Dr Siong Hui-Infectious Diseases

Dr Hui is a specialist in Infectious Diseases. He obtained his medical degree from the University of Auckland in 2002 and completed specialist training in Internal Medicine and Infectious Diseases in New South Wales. His areas of clinical interest include endocarditis and endovascular infections, skin / soft tissue / wound / diabetic foot infections, hepatitis B and C, infections due to multi-resistant organisms, mycobacterial infections and infections in the returned traveller.

He reviews private patients at the Antony Street Specialist Centre, the St John of God Subiaco Hospital and the Hollywood Private Hospital. He is also a consultant at the Fiona Stanley Hospital and Rockingham General Hospital. He administers the Antimicrobial Stewardship (AMS) and Infection Prevention programs at the latter institution. He is active in clinical research concerning cellulitis and hepatitis C, and also conducts AMS-related audits. He had been involved in the training of general practitioners in the management of hepatitis B and C under the auspices of the Australasian Society for Sexual Health Medicine (ASHM).
