The Autism Association of Western Australia is partnering with the WA Health Sector to develop training packages and resources to increase Autism awareness within the health sector.

The ultimate aim of this initiative is to improve access to health care and the health outcomes for individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

This initiative to increase the capability of the health services workforce in Western Australia is aligned to the implementation of the WA Disability Health Framework 2015 - 2025 and the National Disability Insurance Scheme.

Identifying training opportunities to improve awareness amongst the health workforce of the specific needs of individuals with Autism, their families and carers is one strategy identified in the framework.

One of the intended results from this project is the development of online training and resources for health professionals.

To ensure the training and resources we develop are relevant, we want to hear from GPs, hospital staff, regional health workers, Aboriginal health service providers, dentists, gynaecologists, nurses, paramedics and other allied health professionals and get an understanding of the types of training health professionals need to support their patients on the Autism spectrum.
