



What is HealthPathways?

HealthPathways WA is an online portal, managed by the WA Primary Health Alliance (WAPHA) to assist general practitioners (GPs) to find localised referral pathways, specialists and services to provide the most effective treatment for their patients.

Each pathway has been written by GPs in consultation with specialists and other health professionals from across the state.

Pathways are designed to support clinicians during patient consultations, with patient assessment, management and local referral information.

The site is intended to be used at point of care primarily by GPs, but is also available to hospital specialists, allied health, nurses and other health professionals across Western Australia.

The secure portal is not intended for use by patients, however there are a variety of local resources available on the site for GPs to provide to their patients.

Using HealthPathways WA

1. Log on to the website via:
 - <https://wa.healthpathways.org.au> or,
 - Email healthpathways@wapha.org.au to request a username and password
2. Search for the patient's condition
3. Access assessment and management options, and information on referrals to local specialists and services. This may also include links to referral form templates, external providers and information of Medicare Benefits Schedule rebates for chronic disease (if applicable).
