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2021 General Practice Influenza Vaccine Allocation Campaign

WA Primary Health Alliance, WA Department of Health, the Australian Medical Association (WA) and the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners WA have been working closely to improve supply of annual influenza vaccination stock to Western Australian general practices.

These discussions have resulted in an agreement to implement a pre-allocation model for the initial six weeks of the vaccine rollout to ensure a timely and appropriate vaccine supply for Western Australian general practice.

It is hoped this improved system, which includes a contingency for emergency supply, will ensure a more equitable distribution of initial stock for Western Australia's health system's needs, with the necessary flexibility and responsiveness to meet individual practices' particular requirements.

What is the Portal?

WA Primary Health Alliance (WAPHA) has built an online portal that General Practices can use to provide WA Primary Health Alliance with important information required for the 2021 influenza vaccine rollout program.

Why is WAPHA collecting information from General Practices?

As part of the Australian Government's Primary Health Network Program, WA Primary Health Alliance is supporting the rollout of the influenza vaccine allocation to General Practice in Western Australia.

WAPHA, in conjunction with the State Department of Health have calculated the required influenza vaccine allocations per practice based on data

Logging into the Portal to view allocations

You will be able to view your allocations in the portal once they have been approved.

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How to: Portal Registration First Time Users

- The identified key contact for each General Practice will have received an email invitation to log into the portal. This email includes a **unique invitation code** that you will need to register.
- This email will have come from the email address practiceassist@wapha.org.au


IMPORTANT NOTE:

Due to security limitations multiple accounts cannot be provided to organisations for portal access. Your organisation will need to nominate a key contact to act on behalf of your organisation – this individual will be fully responsible for access to and use of the portal. For this reason, the invitation code is unique and has been sent to the individual contact person nominated for this role.

- Please **DO NOT forward** the original email on to others
- For ease of use, data governance and quality control purposes WAPHA requires the nomination of a **single point of contact** from your practice to use the portal.
- Not the key contact person? On registering via the link provided in the original email, you can then update the details with the email address of your preferred point of contact. This can also be changed by contacting Practice Assist and providing alternate details.

To register, you can either:

1. Click the link in the email.
 - a. This will take you to the **'Sign up with and invitation code'** page
 - b. Your unique code will be prefilled in the **'Invitation code'** box
 - c. Click **'Register'** in the blue box to proceed.



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

- III. Are you the key contact? Check with WAPHA by emailing Practice Assist (practiceassist@wapha.org.au)

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

How to: Log in (once registered)

2021 Influenza Vaccine Allocation

WA Primary Health Alliance, WA Department of Health, the Australian Medical Association (WA) and the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners WA have been working closely to improve supply and distribution of annual influenza vaccination stock to Western Australian general practices. These discussions have resulted in an agreement to implement a pre-allocation model (based on a proven model used in the eastern states) for the initial six weeks of the vaccine rollout for

- 6 months to less than 5 years of age
- 5 years to less than 64 years of age (Individuals who are medically at-risk OR individuals who identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander)
- 65 years of age and over
- 5 years of age to less than 13 years of age

This will ensure a timely, appropriate and equitable vaccine supply for general practices. Following the first six weeks, practices will be able to access further supply of 2021 seasonal influenza vaccines through the WA Health online ordering system.

What does this mean for your practice?

Pre-allocation will be determined by the number of active patients (3 visits in 2 years) seen at the practice:

- 6 months to less than 5 years of age
- 5 years to less than 64 years of age (Individuals who are medically at-risk OR individuals who identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander)
- 65 years of age and over
- 5 years of age to less than 13 years of age

The 65 years of age and over pre-allocated vaccine will be distributed in three lots during the 6 week period. Other cohorts pre-allocation will be distributed in either two or three lots depending on when the vaccine arrives.

For those practices that **are not currently sharing data** with WAPHA and/or where there is insufficient data for WAPHA to calculate an estimated allocation, WAPHA is requesting practices to provide the most recent demographics data for the individual cohorts of patients (see list below) to assist with the calculation of influenza vaccine pre-allocations.

- 6 months to less than 5 years of age
- 5 years to less than 64 years of age (Individuals who are medically at-risk OR individuals who identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander)
- 65 years of age and over
- 5 years of age to less than 13 years of age

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Please Note: Individuals who are medically at-risk include those individuals with a condition including: cardiac disease, chronic respiratory conditions, chronic neurological conditions, impaired immunity, diabetes and other metabolic disorders, renal disease, haematological disorders
