

## Identifying patient cohorts at greater risk of severe illness from COVID-19

If your practice has a Pen CS licence supplied by WA Primary Health Alliance (WAPHA), you can use the recipes in the table below to help identify patient cohorts at greater risk of severe illness from COVID-19. The risk factors are based on information from the <u>Australian Government Department of Health</u>.

Risk Factor	Links to Pen CS Recipe
Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander	Indigenous at risk patients
Aged 60+ with chronic conditions	60+ with chronic conditions
Aged 70+	Patients over 70
Smoking	Smoking report
Pregnant	Pregnancy report
Male	Demographics report
Immune suppressive therapy	<u>Immunocompromised</u>
Primary or acquired immunodeficiency	<u>Immunocompromised</u>
Chemotherapy	Patients with cancer
Radiotherapy	Patients with cancer
Immunotherapy	Patients with cancer
Targeted anti-cancer therapy	Patients with cancer
Blood cancer (such as leukaemia, lymphoma or myelodysplastic syndrome)	Patients with cancer
Non-haematological cancer (diagnosed in the past five years)	Patients with cancer
Childhood cancer	Patients with cancer

Chronic inflammatory condition requiring medical treatment	Patients with specific chronic diseases
Bone marrow transplant	Patients with specific chronic diseases
Chronic renal (kidney) failure	<u>CKD</u>
Heart disease (coronary heart disease or failure)	Patients with chronic conditions
Chronic lung disease (excludes mild or moderate asthma)	COVID-19 at risk report
<u>Diabetes</u>	Patients with chronic conditions
Chronic liver disease	COVID-19 at risk report
Neurological conditions such as stroke or dementia	Patients with chronic conditions
Severe mental health condition	Patients with chronic conditions
Severe obesity	Patients with BMI >= 40
Poorly controlled blood pressure	Blood pressure report
At risk patients' booster vaccine status	At risk COVID-19 booster vaccine
Immunocompromised patients due for a third COVID-19 vaccine	Immunocompromised patients due for a third COVID-19 vaccine
