## Your presenters



**Dr David Thomson MBBS FRACP FCSANZ** is an Interventional and General Cardiologist. He completed his original medical training (MBBS) in 2001 at The University of Western Australia with basic physician training through Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital and St John of God Hospital, Subiaco. His 3 years of core Cardiology training was then undertaken at Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital, followed by 12 months of Interventional Cardiology sub-specialty training at Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital. Further sub-specialty training was then undertaken with 12 months at Royal Jubilee Hospital in Victoria, British Columbia (Canada), an internationally renowned radial access service. Dr David Thomson treats public patients at Joondalup Health Campus and private patients at Joondalup Private Hospital.



**Dr Jonathan Teoh MBBS FRACP FCSANZ** is a Cardiologist with a keen interest in general cardiology, chest pain syndromes and ischaemic heart disease, atrial fibrillation, complex valvular disease (e.g. mitral regurgitation and aortic stenosis) and heart failure/cardiomyopathies. His subspecialty is Clinical Echocardiography and is thus an expert in echocardiographic assessment of structural heart disease, stress echocardiography and performance of transoesophageal echocardiograms (TOE's). Dr Teoh travelled to Boston to complete a two-year fellowship as a Clinical and Research Fellow in Advanced Echocardiography at the renowned Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH), Harvard Medical School. He returned thereafter as a Consultant Cardiologist at Joondalup Health Campus with a current appointment as the Director of Echocardiography.



**Prof Barbara Mullan** is employed within the Health Psychology & Behavioural Medicine Research Group, in the School of Psychology at Curtin University. She completed her undergraduate studies in University College Dublin, then completed a Masters in social and organizational psychology. She completed my PhD in health psychology at Cardiff Metropolitan University. Active in all areas of adult cardiology, Dr Gordon performs cardiac catheterisation, transoesophageal echocardiography and has a special interest in echocardiography. Dr Gordon practices privately with Western Cardiology at St John of God Subiaco Hospital.



**Dr Wasing Taggu MBBS, MRC, CCT, FRCP, FESC, FRCP, FRACP** trained at the Essex Cardiothoracic Centre, Papworth, London Chest and London Heart Hospitals, and obtained his CCT (Certificate of Completion of Training) from the East of England Deanery, Cambridge, UK. He is accredited in cardiac rhythm management, cardiovascular CT and echocardiography. He was a consultant cardiologist in the UK for 7 years before joining Joondalup Health Campus, WA in 2018 and has admitting rights for both public and private patients.
