Goldfields workshops

The IAR-DST to guide mental health referrals

The online Initial Assessment and Referral Decision Support Tool (IAR-DST) is designed to be used alongside a comprehensive, holistic mental health assessment to gather information and guide referrals.

WA Primary Health Alliance is providing IAR-DST training in the Goldfields covering two workshops in one session.

GPs and GP registrars who attend the two workshops in one session will be remunerated \$300* and CPD hours are available upon successful completion of both workshops.

Workshop One

Runs for 30 minutes and the training topics include:

- Introduction to the IAR and the development of the IAR national guidance.
- Orientation to the domains, levels of care and the DST.

Workshop Two

Runs for 90 minutes and includes an interactive training session. The training topics include:

- Application of the IAR in assessment and intake settings (practical group activity using vignettes).
- Discussion and reflection from groups.
- Clinical judgement and supported decision making, care preferences and care type.
