The State and Commonwealth Governments committed \$12.55 million over the next four years to establish a Head to Health Kids Hub in WA - as part of the Bilateral Schedule on Mental Health and Suicide Prevention: Western Australia.

The Mental Health Commission are currently working towards localising the pre-existing Australian Government model for the City of Swan area.

The H2H Kids Hubs aim to:

- provide comprehensive, multidisciplinary care which supports children and their families
- improve early intervention outcomes for children's mental health and wellbeing, and
- complement and enhance existing services provided to children and their families.
