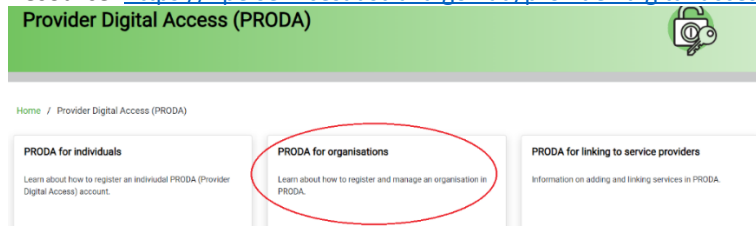

<p>MyMedicare Overview</p>	<p>Services Australia - eLearning MyMedicare Overview Module: https://hpe.servicesaustralia.gov.au/MODULES/MYMED/MYMEDM01/index.html</p>  <p>MyMedicare - Overview This module contains information to help you understand MyMedicare.</p> <p>Note: if your practice is already registered and all participating providers are linked in the Organisation Register, you do not need to complete a second registration process. Once registered, practices are not required to complete further steps until patient registration becomes available from 1 October 2023.</p>
<p>Tips before you start registration</p>	<p>Before commencing your registration, watch the following Services Australia video: Setting up the Organisation Register for program use. Video: https://hpe.servicesaustralia.gov.au/sim_orgreg.html</p>  <p>Setting up the Organisation Register for program use. This simulation will run for approximately 10 minutes and includes information on General Practice Training Payments (GPTP) program registration and banking details</p> <p>Have all your required details at hand ahead of time as you will be logged out of the system if you leave the application open without action for a period of time. Details required for registration include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Registration Authority Number (RA) • Responsible Officer Number (RO) • Banking details • Provider Number • Prescribing Number and • Details of the staff you wish to register including their-mobile numbers and date of birth. <p>Practice Owners can be registered as the Associate, other staff as authorised contacts.</p> <p>You must log into the PRODA account of the principal GP (RO) and go through the process in their account regardless of if you are a delegate (OMO) or not.</p> <p>When you log into PRODA to start the process, also have the Setting up the Organisation Register for program use simulation video open in your internet browser. You can stop and start this simulation as you go through the steps.</p> <p>Note: Where do you find your RA number? HPOS uses your RA number to link services to your account. Here's how to find your RA number:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Login to your PRODA account. 2. Click Profile at the top right menu. 3. The RA number will be listed under the My Details section. <p>If the RA number is not shown, contact the Human Services eBusiness Service Centre on 1800 700 199.</p>

Step 1: Set up your organisation in PRODA

If you haven't already done it, setting up your practice as an Organisation in PRODA is key to accessing the Organisation Register.

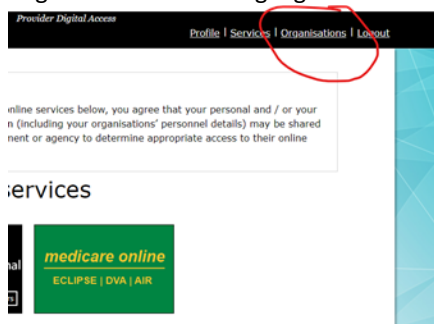

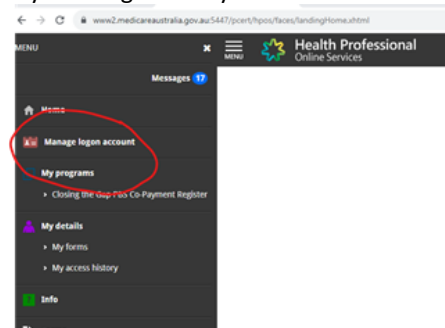

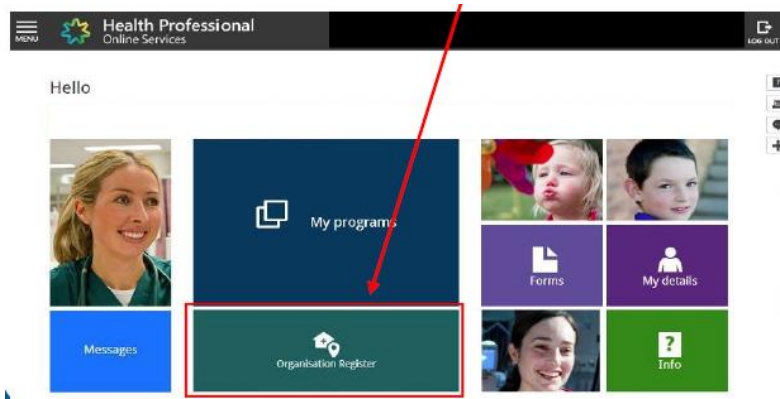


Linking an Organisation in PRODA to HPOS

Tip:

Linking your organisation to HPOS with your ABN, allows you to unlock Organisation Register and get the green Organisation Register tile on the HPOS home screen (as below):



Once linked you can access the Organisation Register via the Organisation Register tile in HPOS at <https://www.servicesaustralia.gov.au/hpos>

Step 3: Record details in the Organisation Record

Using the Organisation Register tile on the HPOS home screen you can record details of your organisation in the Organisation record.
