



STUDY OF GP FOLLOW-UP PROCESSES FOLLOWING A POSITIVE iFOBT

The University of Notre Dame Australia is undertaking a study to investigate follow-up protocols amongst GPs for positive immunochemical faecal occult blood tests (iFOBTs) through the National Bowel Cancer Screening Program.

Interviews focus on GP experiences in providing care following a positive iFOBT. GPs will then be invited to participate in a Consensus Roundtable to discuss and verify the findings from the interviews.

Remuneration as eftpos gift cards will be \$200 for an interview and \$150 for the roundtable. Findings will inform supportive mechanisms for GPs and assist with referral and reporting processes.
