The current syphilis outbreak in WA has resulted in changes to recommendations for clinical practice. The resumption of international travel coupled with postpandemic reductions in vaccination rates make the community more vulnerable to outbreaks of diseases such as measles, mumps and pertussis.

Post-exposure prophylaxis for rabies is urgent, therefore clinicians should be aware of processes toward initiating management.
