10983	Attendance by an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health practitioner, Aboriginal health worker or practice nurse to provide clinical support to a patient who: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> is participating in a Telehealth consultation with a specialist and is located at an Aboriginal Medical Service or within a Telehealth eligible area and at the time of the attendance is at least 15km by road from the specialist, physician or psychiatrist 	\$32.40
