Abrysvo is recommended for pregnant women between 28 weeks and 36 weeks gestation.

Beyfortus is only given if mother did not receive Abrysvo or if the dose was administered within 2 weeks or less of giving birth.

Beyfortus will be available from 1 April 2025 for all eligible infants born from 1 October 2024 until 30 September 2025.

Beyfortus should also be administered to Aboriginal and other medically at-risk children entering their second winter season (refer to the WA Department of Health immunisation website for more information).
