## General Practices and Aboriginal Medical Services

Item	Description
<b>Tests and diagnostics</b>	
11707	<b>ECG</b> Twelve-lead, tracing and report
73806	<b>Pregnancy Test</b> By one or more immunochemical methods
11309	<b>Audiogram</b> Air conduction
11506	<b>Spirometry</b> Including recorded tracing before and after inhalation of bronchodilator
<b>Visit with nurse or Aboriginal health practitioner</b>	
16400	<b>Antenatal service</b> Provided by a midwife, nurse or Aboriginal health practitioner in a regional, rural or remote location. Up to 10 services per pregnancy
10988	<b>Immunisation</b> Provided by an Aboriginal health practitioner (for example Fluvax)
10989	<b>Wound dressing</b> By an Aboriginal health practitioner, under the supervision of a general practitioner
<b>Procedures performed by general practitioner</b>	
14206	<b>Hormone or living tissue implant</b> By cannula e.g. Implanon insertion
30003	<b>Burns Dressing</b> Localised burns, including consultation
30026	<b>Wound repair</b> <7cm, superficial, excluding face or neck
30029	<b>Wound repair</b> <7cm, deeper tissue, excluding face or neck
30032	<b>Wound repair</b> <7cm, superficial on face or neck
30035	<b>Wound repair</b> <7cm, deeper tissue, on face or neck
30061	<b>Removal of superficial foreign body</b> Including from cornea or sclera
30062	<b>Removal of estonogestrel subcutaneous implant</b> As an independent procedure
30064	<b>Removal of Subcutaneous Foreign Body</b> Requiring incision and exploration +/- wound closure

<b>Procedures performed by general practitioner</b>	
30071	<b>Biopsy of skin</b> Sent for pathology
30072	<b>Biopsy of mucous membrane</b> Sent for pathology
30107	<b>Ganglion or small bursa excision</b> Independent procedure
30192	<b>Ablation premalignant skin lesions</b> Treatment of 10 or more premalignant skin lesions
30196	<b>Curettage or laser removal of malignant neoplasm of skin or mucous membrane, serial curettage or laser</b>
30202	<b>Cryotherapy</b> Removal of malignant neoplasm of skin or mucous membrane
30216	<b>Aspiration of Haematoma,</b>
30219	<b>Abscess/Haematoma</b> Incision and drainage of, excl aftercare
31356	<b>Malignant skin lesion#</b> Surgical excision and repair (other than shave excision) that meets all criteria see <a href="#">MBS Online description</a> .
32072	<b>Sigmoidoscopic Examination</b> With or without biopsy
32147	<b>Perianal Thrombosis</b> Incision of
41500	<b>Ear – removal of foreign body</b> Other than by simple syringing
47361	<b>Fracture of Radius or Ulna</b> Cast immobilisation
47904	<b>Toenail removal</b> In clinic
47915	<b>Ingrown toenail</b> Wedge resection portion of nail bed
47916	<b>Ingrown toenail</b> Partial resection (phenol/electrocautery/laser to nail bed)
