Population/Public Health Unit (PHU) Assistance for Immunisation Providers

The Population/Public Health Unit (PHU) teams work collaboratively with immunisation providers to deliver WA immunisation programs and implement strategies to improve immunisation rates.

What assistance does the PHU offer?

The PHU can help immunisation providers in a variety of ways by delivering the following assistance:

- Support and information regarding the National Immunisation Program (NIP) schedule and vaccines.
- Assist providers to formulate catch-up plans for children/adolescents under the age of 20 years.
 Also assistance with catch up plans for persons of any cage with asplenia and/or pre-/post splenectomy.
- Advice regarding the management of children who are overdue for immunisations on their 10A list from the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR). This can include advice with correcting doses/dates/codes on AIR and assistance with notifying AIR when a child moves overseas.
- Provide assistance with the translation of non-English overseas immunisation records. This process can take a few weeks.
- Support for Aboriginal families and practices in relation to immunisations, including cultural support from Aboriginal Health Liaison Officers.
- Clinical nurse specialist site visits or virtual visits as required, which may be delivered in conjunction with WA Primary Health Alliance (WAPHA) practice support staff.


