



# Primary Sense Reports for Cervical Screening

Primary Sense can provide reports based on real-time data, allowing practices to monitor performance and focus on clinical outcomes. The features and functionality of reports can support roles across the practice team. Generated reports are automatically saved to a folder on the computer, enabling data comparison over time.

#### Quick tip! Accessing reports for Cervical Screening Access the National Cancer Screening Register (NCSR) At the top of the Primary Sense sidebar menu: online for up-to-date cervical click Reports and select keyword filter: Cervical screening patient information. Update practice records with data. • Filter within the report for 'N' under cervical screening and use search to find GP name or other complexities. Identify the % of female patients with an up-to-date PIP QI report - 10 measures cervical screening (last 5 years) and track your compliance % compliance with the PIPQI measures. For further interrogation of data to target specific areas otherwise not highlighted, reports can be exported to Excel or CSV for enhanced manipulation and filtering.

## Quality improvement (QI) opportunities

- Develop a process for recalling a cohort of patients overdue for cervical screening e.g., particular age group, patients of a particular GP.
- Implement an activity to ensure screening results are recorded in the relevant section of clinical software.
