



# Primary Sense Reports for Ethnicity Recorded

Primary Sense can provide reports based on real-time data, allowing practices to monitor performance and focus on clinical outcomes. The features and functionality of reports can support roles across the practice team. Generated reports are automatically saved to a folder on the computer, enabling data comparison over time.

## Accessing reports for Ethnicity Recorded

Accessing reports for Ethnicity Recorded At the top of the Primary Sense sidebar menu: click <b>Reports</b> and select keyword filter: <b>Ethnicity</b>	<b>Quick tip!</b> Have your practice staff completed Cultural Awareness training?
Patients booked in with missing PIP QI measures With appointments in the next 2 weeks	<ul> <li>Identify patients without ethnicity recorded and with an upcoming booked appointment.</li> <li>Filter results by clicking on each column. Clicking on columns rearranges the results, for example for each doctor or appointment date.</li> </ul>
Patients missing PIP QI or accreditation Measures All patients missing measures	<ul><li>Identify patients without ethnicity recorded.</li><li>Filter options to target specific focus groups within the report such as age or risk factors.</li></ul>
Accreditation % compliance	<ul> <li>Identify the % of ethnicity recorded within your practice patient population.</li> </ul>
Your Practice Data Quality Compared to PHN average	• Compare your practice % of ethnicity recorded in comparison to the PHN average.
PIP QI report - 10 measures % compliance	<ul> <li>Identify the % of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander patients aged 35 to 44 years old with CVD Assessment risk factors recorded.</li> </ul>
For further interrogation of data to target specific areas otherwise not highlighted, reports can be	

exported to Excel or CSV for enhanced manipulation and filtering.

### Quality improvement (QI) opportunities

- Develop a process for clinical staff regarding methods to capture and record patient ethnicity.
- Implement an activity to track recording of patient ethnicity to underpin targeted care.
