


Primary Sense Reports Overview

Accessing Reports

On the Desktop icon, click on the 'Reports' tab.

You can select a report by title or search for a specific topic in a report by using the "Keyword filter" section. To download a report, double click on the report of choice.



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Information Headings

The Questions at the top of most reports expand, containing relevant information on what patients and data are captured in the report, how you could use the report, and an explanation on the ACG Complexity levels.

In addition to this, tables are presented with a sub-heading providing a further explanation to aid in understanding of the information within the table.

Report Functions

There are four functions within most Primary Sense reports.

Show: Click on the arrows to choose the number of patients displayed per page.



Description of Reports Available

Please see table below for the complete list of Primary Sense reports and a brief overview of each. These are grouped according to report types, i.e. Patient Lists, Practice/PHN reports, PIP QI Reports and Primary Sense Information.

Primary Sense – available reports	
Patient Lists	
Pregnant and vaccinations	Missing vaccinations during pregnancy
Chronic Lung Disease and Asthma	COPD, Asthma and Chronic lung conditions, Spirometry, and vaccination history
Cardiovascular Disease Risk Factors	CV risk assessment score, BP, medications prescribed and lifestyle risk factors
Health Assessments	Missing Health assessments for 40-49-year-old, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders and 75+ years
Haemochromatosis	Potential missed diagnosis of hemochromatosis based on Ferritin test results
Diabetes Mellitus	Identifies potential missed diagnosis of diabetes by elevated Fasting BSL and no HbA1c recorded, Coded diabetes patients with status of measures, pathology and influenza vaccination completed/missing
Patients with Moderate Complexity (Level 3)	Coordination of care using MBS items for ACG risk stratified patients 3 (N.B. generally a very large report report)
Patients with High Complexity (Levels 4 and 5)	Coordination of care using MBS items for ACG risk stratified patients 4 and 5 (separated into 2 lists)
Benzodiazepine in substance misuse	Patients with substance misuse or history of substance misuse and are prescribed a benzodiazepine medication, who may be eligible for Mental Health Care Plan or Mental Health Care Plan Review.
COVID-19 Vulnerable Patients Vaccination eligibility and status	Vulnerable patients who may be eligible for COVID-19 vaccination including COVID-19 first and second dose status, influenza vaccine status and pneumovax status.

Characteristics of the Practice Patient Population	Overview of demographics, ACG risk stratification scores across total age grouped practice population
Your Practice Data Quality	Snapshot of current % completion of Coded diagnosis, Alcohol, Allergy, BMI, BP, Ethnicity and Smoking status recorded for total practice population
Summary Report of Practice Improvements	A report that monitors changes in each report (numbers only) over regular time frames. This will support tracking of progress in CQI activities
Characteristics of the PHN patient population	Overview of demographics, ACG risk stratification scores across total age grouped and aggregated from all practices submitting data via Primary Sense™ for the PHN
Accreditation	Snapshot of current % completion of Alcohol, Allergy, BMI, Ethnicity and Smoking status recorded on RACGP Active practice population (seen 3 times in 2 years)

PIP QI	
PIP QI Report – 10 measures	Report on the 10 PIP QI measures PIP QI Improvement measures as % completion rate for the RACGP Active practice population (seen 3 times in 2 years)
Patients booked in with missing PIP QI measures	List of patients with 1 or missing PIP QI measures recorded with an existing booked appointment in the next 2 weeks
Patients missing PIP QI/Accreditation Measures	All patients missing one or more accreditation or PIP QI measure

What's new and FAQs	Useful information for users regarding new features and common questions
Troubleshooting Guide	Provides useful tips to resolve issues
