

# Advance care planning (ACP) core training guide

## Implementing ACP into routine health assessments for older adults in general practice

### Introduction

The resources outlined in this training guide aim to assist GPs, nurse practitioners, practice nurses and non-clinical staff in general practice to develop an increased understanding of advance care planning (ACP) and support the implementation of ACP as part of routine health assessments for older adults (aged 75+ and the Aboriginal health assessment 50+).

Completion of the ACP core training resources aim to:

- Increase promotion and awareness of ACP.
- Improve the uptake of ACP ensuring that completed documents meet WA legislation.
- Ensure correct storage of completed ACP documents.
- Enhance patient choice and promote participation in future care planning decisions.
- Align scope of routine health assessments with RACGP recommendations relating to the inclusion of ACP.
