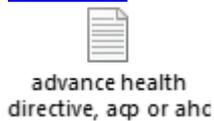

**QI Quintuple Aims for health care improvement:**

**10 PIP QI Measures.**

1. diabetes with HbA1c result
2. smoking status
3. weight classification
4. 65+ and Influenza Immunisation
5. Diabetes and Influenza Immunisation
6. COPD and Influenza Immunisation
7. alcohol consumption status
8. risk factors enable CVD assessment
9. cervical screening
10. diabetes & blood pressure
