Strengthening Immunisation and Cancer Screening Preventative Health Forums

Join us for one of the Immunisation and Cancer Screening Preventative Health Forums in Perth South or Perth North.

These in-person events are designed to support practice nurses with understanding the National Immunisation Program (NIP), administering vaccinations and increasing cancer screening rates.

The forums will cover the following topics:

- The importance of the different vaccines – why and when they should be administered.
- Cultural safety during immunisation appointments.
- Cold chain management – from receiving vaccines in the practice to administering and recording in the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR).
- The Western Australian Vaccine Safety Surveillance (WAVSS) System – what and where to report.
- Updates about the four national cancer screening programs – breast, bowel, cervical and lung.
- The National Cancer Screening Register (NCSR) and how integrating it into eligible software can assist clinicians.
