

8. Notifications

When a practice has not extracted data from the clinical software system via the Primary Sense extractor for more than 24 hours, the top three tiles will display in orange - see Figure 1 below.

When the Primary Sense extractor has stopped running, the top three tiles will display in red. Clicking the Reports or Alerts button will display a message - see Figure 2 below.

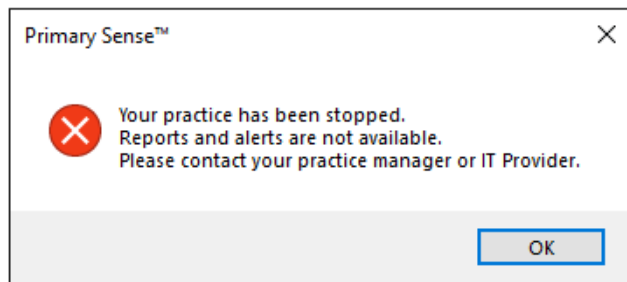
If your desktop app is displaying orange or red tiles, contact your practice manager or IT provider to verify whether the extractor is running.



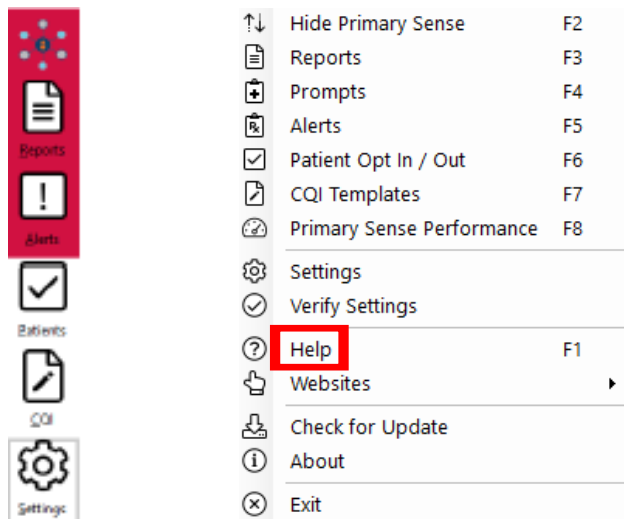
